CIRCULAR TO ALL BRANCHES/OFFICES

Bank of India Retired Employees' Medical Assistance Scheme

 Revision in the limits for reimbursing Domiciliary expenses / Insurance Premium / Hospitalisation expenses to the members.

Bank of India Retired Employees' Medical Assistance Scheme, is in operation in our Bank since 1997. Detailed guidelines / instructions in respect of the said Scheme have been circulated vide Branch Circular No. 91/155 dated 4th December, 1997.

- 2. We are pleased to advise you that during the last Central Welfare Committee meeting, it was proposed to revise the limits for reimbursement of expenses incurred by members of the said Scheme. The Board has accorded approval for allocation of funds for such revision in the Board Meeting held on 25th June, 2007.
- 3. In terms of the said decision, the revision in the limits regarding reimbursement of expenses to be granted under the captioned Scheme during the current Welfare Year 2007-08, would be as follows:-

- 4. Please note that the revision in the limits as mentioned in para 3 above are effective from the date of sanction i.e. 25th June, 2007 meaning thereof that the revised limits are applicable for the expenses incurred by the members of the Scheme after the said date i.e. 25th June, 2007.
- 5. We further wish to advise that a decision has also been taken to entrust the Management of the said Scheme to a Trust, which is presently being looked after by a separate Managing Committee as per the original guidelines of the Scheme. A separate Branch Circular is being issued regarding the revised guidelines / instructions for operation of the captioned Scheme. Till such time, all other guidelines / instructions communicated vide Branch Circular No.91/155 dated 4th December, 1997 and subsequent administrative guidelines issued from time to time are to be adhered as it is.
- 6. Please bring the contents of this Circular Letter to the notice of all staff members.
